## Mark 5:22-24, 35-42

<sup>22</sup> Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet. <sup>23</sup> He pleaded earnestly with him, “My little daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live.” <sup>24</sup> So Jesus went with him.

<sup>35</sup> While Jesus was still speaking, some people came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. “Your daughter is dead,” they said. “Why bother the teacher anymore?”

<sup>36</sup> Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, **“Don’t be afraid; just believe.”**

<sup>37</sup> He did not let anyone follow him except Peter, James and John the brother of James. <sup>38</sup> When they came to the home of the synagogue leader, Jesus saw a commotion, with people crying and wailing loudly. <sup>39</sup> He went in and said to them, “Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep.” <sup>40</sup> But they laughed at him.

After he put them all out, he took the child’s father and mother and the disciples who were with him, and went in where the child was. <sup>41</sup> He took her by the hand and said to her, “*Talitha koum!*” (which means “Little girl, I say to you, get up!”).

<sup>42</sup> Immediately the girl stood up and began to walk around (she was twelve years old). At this they were completely astonished.

Please come forward in an orderly fashion  
Being respectful of those before you

When it is your turn, please step forward

The Pastor will ask your need for prayer

Note, if your prayer need is personal simply state:

“It is an unspoken request”

(God knows the deepest needs of our heart)

The Pastor and Elders will then place their hands upon you and while the Pastor prays aloud the Elders will pray silently. You will also notice others sitting in pews who are also at prayer especially for you.

You may be handed a “Comfort Cross” to hold during your time of prayer. If you would like to have this cross you only need to ask and one will be provided along with a velvet pouch.

After the prayer you may resume your place and pray for others who have come in need for prayer.
